In 2021, according to Mental Health America, approximately 66,000 youth in Indiana suffered from at least 1 Major Depressive Episode. Recent studies across the country indicate that **approximately one in five teens between ages twelve and eighteen suffer from at least one diagnosable mental health disorder**. The toll these take on our youth can lead to severe consequences.

Ben's Ranch Foundation is named for and based upon the experience of a young man here in Indiana, whose struggles with bipolar disorder were suspended and his life greatly enriched and extended by his 18-month adventure on a mustang ranch in Wyoming during his late teen years. The positive impact that experience had on Ben is the foundation for and inspiration behind this program.

When we decided to organize our first ever Poker Run, it wasn't hard for my team to choose a cause to support. This not-for-profit, charitable foundation based in Indianapolis was created to support and give teens with mental health challenges new ways to improve their lives by connecting them to the healing powers of the farm, ranch life and equine assisted therapies thru paid internships.
